## COVID-19 UPDATE 4: TUESDAY 24 MARCH 2020

A second metropolitan COVID-19 drive-through facility has opened today at Hampstead Rehabilitation Centre, in Adelaide's North East, to further increase the testing options for South Australians.

The drive-through facility is an effective, safe and convenient method to enable people with a GP referral to be tested for COVID-19.

The facility at Hampstead is one of many dedicated COVID-19 facilities across metropolitan and regional areas. More information about testing centres locations can be found [here](#).

### In other updates:

- > SA Health has developed a [Fact Sheet](#) for businesses and organisations about what to do if a person at work is being tested or has tested positive for COVID-19. It also provides advice for good hygiene and cleaning practices and social distancing in the workplace.
- > Border control enforcement officially came into effect at 4pm today for travellers entering South Australia. Police will be stopping travellers at checking points and names and details will be recorded, including their South Australian address for the period of self-quarantine.

Exemptions are available to people entering the state who are classified as an 'essential traveller'. More information is available on the South Australian Police [website](#).

### SOUTH AUSTRALIA COVID-19 CASES

Since 1 February 2020, there have been 170 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in South Australia.

While the majority of cases can be traced to overseas travel, interstate travel or confirmed contact of a known case, SA Health is investigating the first potential case of community transmission within South Australia.
