COVID-19 UPDATE 7: FRIDAY 27 MARCH 2020

A quick summary of the South Australian COVID-19 stats:

- > 22 additional people tested positive today (27 March).
- > 257 confirmed cases in total.
- > Only **2** of the 257 cases have recorded no interstate or overseas travel and are classed as local transmission.
- > All other confirmed cases have recently returned from overseas, interstate, or are a close contact of a previously confirmed case.
- South Australians are receiving care at the Royal Adelaide Hospital's Intensive Critical Care Unit.
- > **53** cases are linked to the Ruby Princess Cruise Ship (77 cases in total linked to cruise ships).
- > As of 26 March, >6,650 people have been tested at metro COVID clinics and SA Pathology has undertaken >23,500 tests.

To help flatten the curve, remember to practice <u>social distancing</u> and help <u>stop the spread</u> by practising good hand hygiene and covering coughs and sneezes.

In other updates:

- > From 11.59pm, Saturday 27 March, States and Territories will be <u>quarantining all arrivals</u> to Australia for two weeks in hotels and other facilities, with the Australian Defence Force assisting with enforcement compliance checks.
