What's Involved?

- You call the Speak My Language SA Coordinator who will link you to a trained bi-lingual facilitator.
- They chat with you and plan a casual style interview. Questions are designed (with you if you wish) to help you explore and share your information.
- Interviews are conducted and recorded on-line, via phone or in-person.
- Sound editing ensures excellent sound quality and removes any 'ums' or 'arrs' or other content you would like removed.
- You and/or your management can listen to the final product before deciding to approve publication.
- If you wish, you can receive a copy of our Quality Assurance Check, conducted by a speaker of the community language that the interview is in (this person is not the interviewer and comes from a different state).
- Podcasts will be available free for download.
- Once publication occurs, Speak My Language will promote the podcast widely via social media, print and radio.
- With your permission, we may use 'grabs' to include in community language radio broadcasts.
