- Possess a certificate, diploma or higher qualification
- Are based in Adelaide (you will be placed at the organisation's head office or branch locations)
- Have a valid ABN or are able to apply for one (this makes it easier to pay your allowance)
- Are available for 15 hours per week plus an additional 1-2 hours for your coaching and mentoring
